




# NORTHERN RIVERS REGIONAL DOUBLES TOURNAMENT 2023

Age divisions are planned to be 50+, 60+ and 65+ with skill levels of 2 - 3.0, 3 - 4.0 and Open. Due to court limitations singles events cannot be offered.

The tournament has been sanctioned by PAA and is expected to be loaded to the Pickleball Brackets Tournament list by first week of December. So, save the date now, start getting your partners together and arrange practice games as soon as practicable. Players or other interested parties who are unable to play, please consider volunteering your time to help run the event as check-in hosts, court scorer coordinators, first aid assistants, or qualified referees.
